What happens if NAS campus re-opens later than anticipated?

- Further contingencies have been developed in order to respond to any delay of reopening the campus. These include:
 - Further revision of semester 2 to utilise currently scheduled breaks for teaching.
 - Further Extension of the Academic Year into early 2021 if required.

What happens if NAS campus re-opens sooner than anticipated?

- In the event that NAS campus re-opens sooner than expected, NAS will re-commence face to face teaching at the earliest practical opportunity.
- A key focus will be the provision of studio and workshop access for students as soon as possible.






